Year 11 lessons during the examination season

I would like to begin by congratulating the Year 11 students on the positive attitude they have displayed in response to the demands of the GCSE examinations to date and their preparations for the examinations that begin next week (Art) and then run to the 18 June. The first Science examination is on 13 May.

Up to – and including – the week of 10 June, all lessons will run as usual and students will be required to attend school on a full time basis. In subjects where they have no examination (e.g. core PE) or in subjects where the final examination is taken before the week of 10 June, students will still be expected to attend these lessons. They will of course be given quiet time during these periods to revise – using their own revision resources – for any other subject.

Breakfast and pre-examination sessions have been organised and the programme is attached. Please note there are also some Saturdays; German speaking practice will run on Bank Holiday Monday (6 June) from 10am. Students have already been given copies of this and we have explained the arrangements to them. The programme for May half term will follow shortly.


